

The Lord Has Many Names

The purpose of this project is to help children identify various names of the Lord and think about His many qualities.

Suggested Supplies:

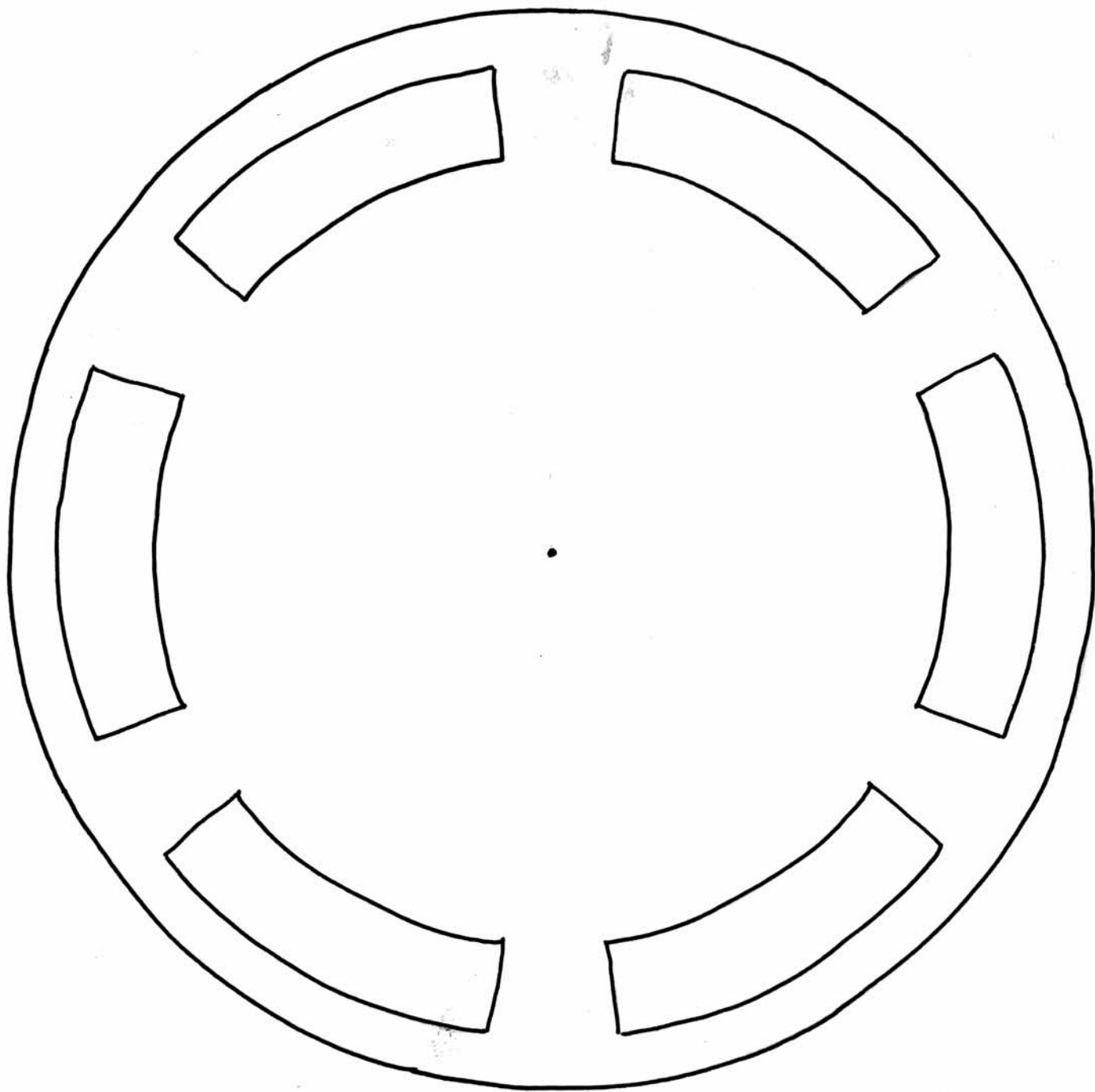
1 - 9"x12" white oaktag	pencil
1 - 9"x12" red oaktag	scissors or x-acto knife
1 brass brad	crayons

Project instructions:

1. How many names can you think of for the Lord? Make a list of them. Some examples are Lord, Jesus, God, Christ, Messiah, Heavenly Father, King, Shepherd, Creator, Savior, Redeemer, Almighty. Then choose six of these names and print one of them neatly with pencil in each of the spaces on the white paper.
2. Carefully cut out the window indicated on the piece of red paper.
3. Cut out the circles on the red and white paper pieces.
4. Place the red circle on top of the white circle and attach them in the center using the brass brad.
5. With crayons, make a picture of the Lord in the center of the red circle. The brad can be part of the waistband.
6. Now you can turn the red circle around and show some of the names of the Lord you have learned.
