

My Good Deeds Book

The purpose of this project is to help children reflect on how the Ten Commandments can affect daily life.

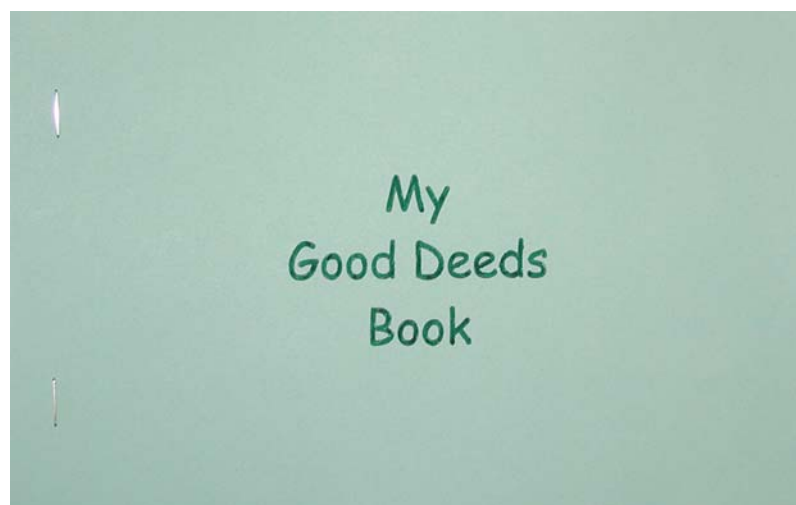
Suggested Supplies:

2 - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow cover stock
10 - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " white paper

crayons, colored pencils or markers
pencil

Project instructions:

1. Using crayons, colored pencils or markers, trace "My Good Deeds Book" for the front cover of the book.
2. Assemble the book by putting the white pages in between the green front and back covers. Staple it on the left side to hold the book together.
3. Write a number at the bottom of each white page with a pencil. There are ten pages in all.
4. Use crayons, colored pencils or markers to draw a picture on each page. You may want to have students do one each day. Ask students to think about what they have done that day to obey one of the commandments or something they have done to help other people. Draw a picture of it and label it at the bottom. Tell students that they might be surprised how easy it is to remember the Lord and His commandments if they take time each day to think about it. Encourage students to thank the Lord for helping them understand the life that leads to heaven and for helping them try to live it each day.
