

LESSON 27 – CASCADE NEW CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL

Text: "Let the Little Children Come to Me" – Matthew 19:13-15,
Mark 10: 13-16, or Luke 18:15-17

Recitation:

"Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 19:14).

Themes:

1. The children will create "a gold medal with a blue ribbon" for being like an infant/child: humble, willing to be led, knows they need others.

Activity:

The idea is to make pendants, showing a cut out of an infant – better yet a picture of themselves as an infant, if parents can be alerted ahead of time to bring in a picture of each child that can be cut. Also, a "Parent" magazine provides a great supply of pictures.

Spray juice can lids gold and punches a hole with hammer and nail. Put in an "O" ring--make sure "O" ring to go through the punched hole is big enough. Attach "O" rings ahead of time for kids. Bring thin blue ribbon (or string) and put through hole and make medallion. Glue picture of infant on the front and the recitation to the back.

Adaptation for Toddlers:

Bring in lots of dolls to hug! They can take turns showing how Jesus hugged the "children."
