basic supplies:



materials:

- safety razors or exacto knives
- heavy construction paper (or very thin cardboard)
- pencils, scissors
- light or lamp
- mirror behind a curtain

teacher preparation:

- set up the mirror behind a curtain in a corner of the room, with the words written on a sign, "You are the man"
- have a blank wall ready for projecting shadow figures onto
- make a sample
- prepare a surface to cut on that will not get scratched

procedure:

- children draw and cut out of their heavy paper these figures: rich man, poor man, many herds & flocks, one lamb
- using the light, cast shadow figures on the wall as you talk about the story, covering up the one little lamb as he is taken away
- After discussing how we should look through these stories to how they apply to us, send each child with his stencil to the curtain, and have them privately look through the cut-outs at themselves in the mirror. (see if they can keep secret what they see)



notes: encourage them to not crowd figures or paper may fall apart
