basic supplies:



materials: scissors, pencils, paper (chalk)

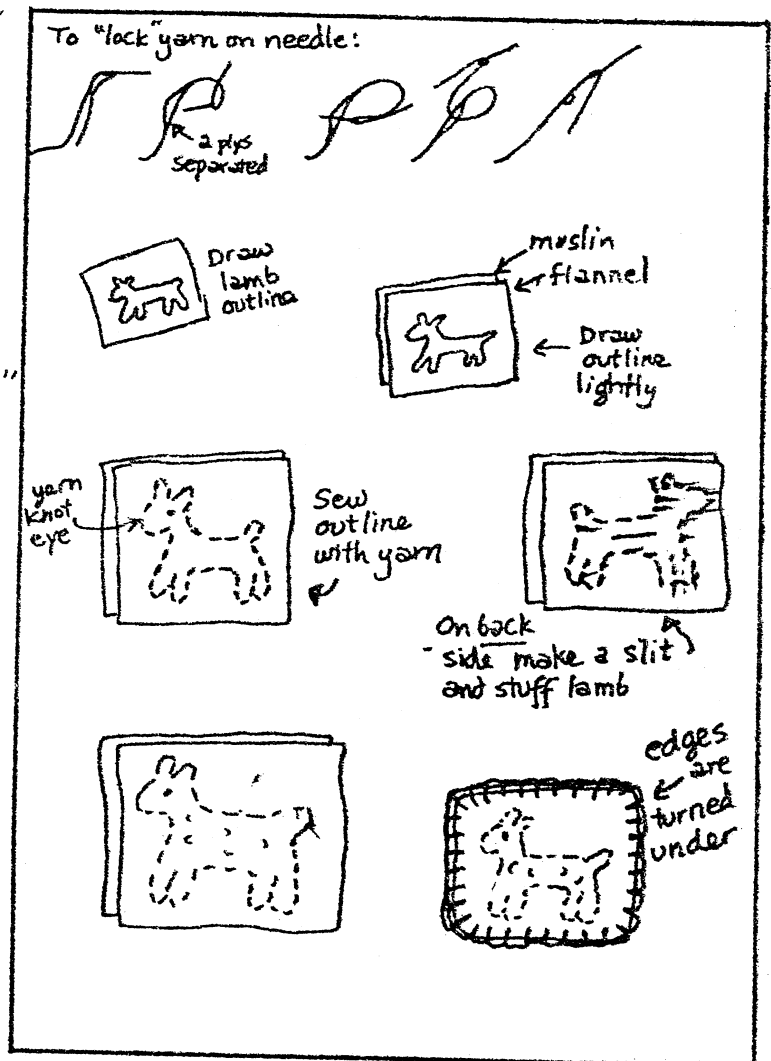
- white flannel
- muslin
- stuffing or batting or cotton
- black or brown yarn (or other color)
- large needles, pins

teacher preparation:

- Make sample
- Thread needles with yarn and "lock" (go back between plies)
- Cut out squares of muslin & flannel (2 muslin, 1 flannel per child) about 6" or so (cut paper too)

procedure:

- children draw a simple lamb on paper and then copy lightly on flannel with pencil or chalk
- sewing through both flannel and a layer of muslin, using a running stitch, children outline their lambs
- on back side (muslin) cut a small slit and stuff lamb lightly with batting or cotton (this is called trapunto)
- the lamb will puff nicely. Sew a yarn knot eye
- teacher pins flannel/muslin to 2nd muslin, turning in edges, and child sews into a pillow with large blanket or running stitch
- stuff when 3/2 sides are sewn
- sew closed



notes: sewing can be completed at home by hand or machine if time runs out
