

A BASKET OF USES

Procedure:

1. Gather an array of tools, raw materials, and other things that help people serve in a variety of uses.
2. Put them in a basket or a box.
3. Pull them out one by one and let the children try to identify how each thing could be used to help other people.

Some Suggestions of Things to Put in the Basket:

Diaper and baby toy
The Word
Knitting needles and yarn
Cleaning sponge (one that is brand new)
Books (fiction and nonfiction)
Hammer and nails
Silverware and napkin (for helping to set the table for a meal)
Telephone
Rolling pin or wooden spoon
Dish towel (for drying dishes)
Stethoscope or thermometer
Watercolors and paintbrush
Pipe wrench
Camera
Harmonica or Recorder
Clay
Pen or Pencil
