



## LESSON 34 – CASCADE NEW CHURCH SUNDAY SCHOOL

Text: Coming to the Lord's Feast – Luke 14:15-24

Recitation:

"Go out into the highways, and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled" (*Luke* 14:23).

Themes:

1. Discuss how this story is about people going to heaven also. The Lord calls out and wants to fill His "house," but many are reluctant and/or unwilling.

Activity:

Prepare a "feast" with paper things and foods (cheese, grapes, pita bread, juice, figs or dates, nuts, crackers) trying to make it look realistic. (In addition, bring a tablecloth, cups, napkins and/or plates.) Have children act out the story the Lord told. Discuss the theme above. Act out people who refuse and then have those who are lame, poor, and blind being brought in. Perhaps get adults after their service to be the ones who come in or perhaps use the toddlers.

Adaptation for Toddlers:

Let toddlers help with feast or have their own. Practice being servants to each other. Perhaps attend feast with the older children. The toddlers can be the ones who wanted to come.
