basic supplies:



materials:

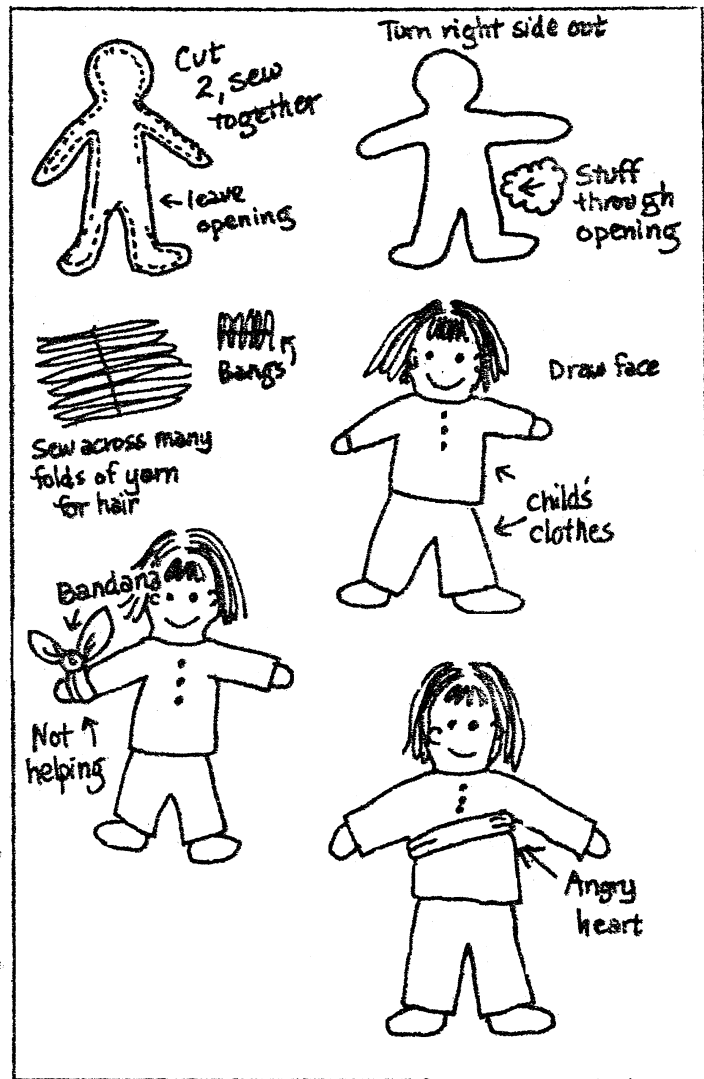
- muslin, old sheet or other fabric
- stuffing (polyester, cotton or even newspaper)
- magic markers, yarn
- child's clothes (borrow or buy at garage sale)
- bandana or ace bandage

teacher preparation:

- cut out and sew a simple body shape on the sewing machine
- turn right side out, stuff and hand sew opening closed
- dress in child's clothes
- draw face
- make hair of yarn, hand sew on (could put in pony tails or braids)

procedure:

- talk about different "diseases" we can have, and wrap the "sick" part of the doll with bandana
 - e.g. when we don't listen - ears;
 - when we don't look for ways to help our parents - eyes;
 - when we don't follow the LORD and His WORD - feet;
 - when we say bad things - mouth;
 - when we have an angry feeling - heart;
 - when we don't help others - hands



NOTES: you could make the figure of cardboard, or use a large doll
 - save doll for other illustrations in Sunday School
