

A Harvest Display

Collect a variety of foods that are “fruits of the harvest” and display these near your worship center—perhaps placed around the Word—or as a centerpiece on your kitchen table. Try to select a variety of fruits, vegetables, nuts, and grains that are grown in your part of the world.

Let your children help you arrange all these things near the Word or some other special place.

You might want to make a special sign to go with the display. Here are a few suggestions:
