

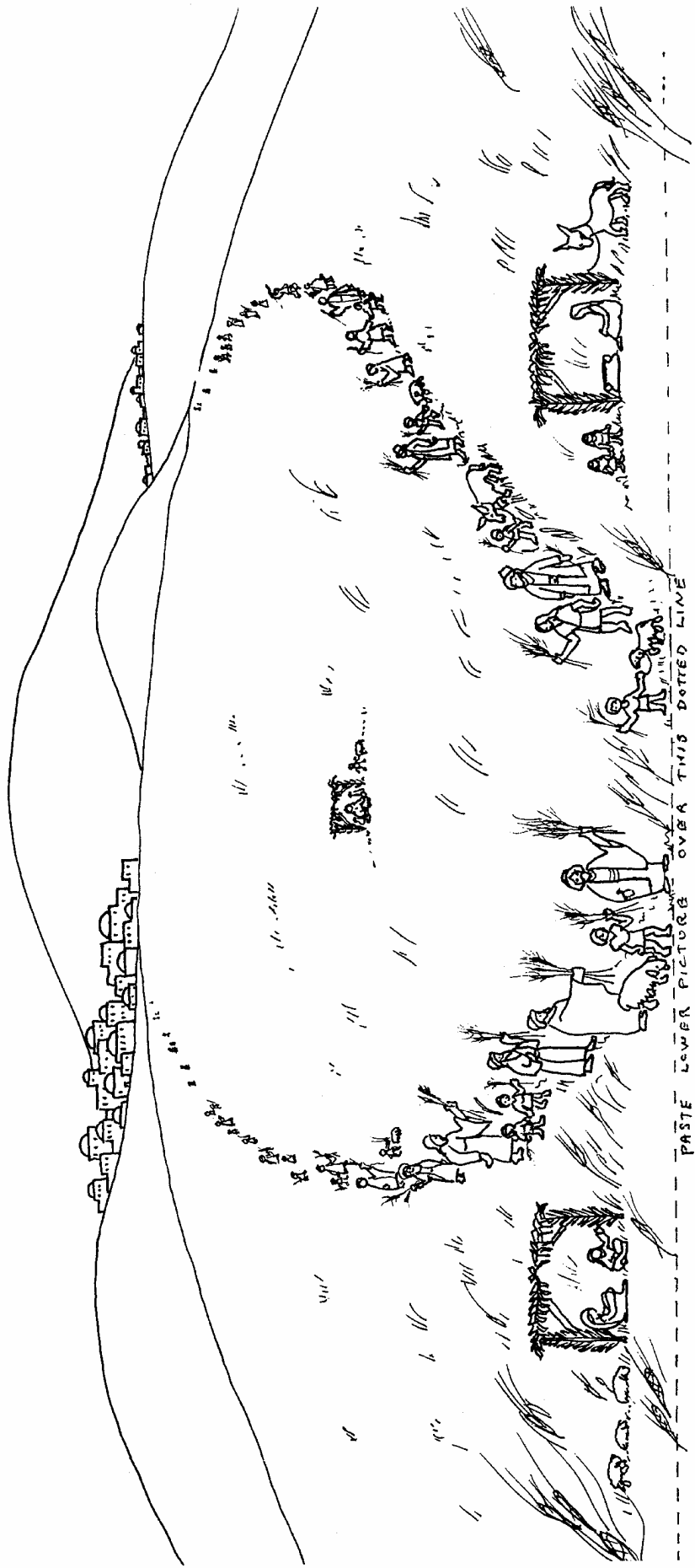


The Feast of Ingathering

Here is a picture of the Children of Israel celebrating the Feast of Ingathering which was sometimes called the Feast of Tabernacles. The men and boys are taking wheat and fruit to be blessed by the high priest. The women and girls are sitting in "booths" or tabernacles.

Coloring these pictures might be a good family project. Here are some suggestions for painting the pictures before assembling them.

1. Color the sky blue and the hills soft green and brown.
2. Color the rest of the picture a light yellow wheat color. Use water color if possible, going over everything.
3. When the water color has dried, color the Children of Israel and the priests, booths, and animals. You can use crayon or water color.
4. Now trim the top edge of the picture showing the high priest blessing the food (cutting along the dotted line).
5. Make this picture overlap the bottom edge of the other page, and then glue the sheets together.

Directions for Completing the Project

Color both pictures.

Then cut along the dotted line below.

Glue this page onto the other page, first overlapping the pages so that there is no gap in the picture.
