1. One piece of lightweight yellow paper
2. Red and orange crayons
3. Scissors
4. A piece of light cardboard—an old cereal box will do fine
5. Tape

Directions:

1. Cut 3 men and 1 angel out of cardboard. (*Cut your own simple shapes or trace just the outline of the pattern below onto cardboard.*)
2. Tape the 4 cutouts to one side of the yellow paper.
3. Turn the yellow paper over. This is the window to the fiery furnace.
