

The Lord as the Center

Materials:

construction paper or cardstock for a background – any color
brass paper fasteners
crayons, markers, or colored pencils for coloring
tape

Directions:

- 1) Color the faces on the large circle and the Lord's face on the small circle. You may also wish to color the circle around the Lord with rays of light.
- 2) Cut out both circles.
- 3) Push the prongs of the paper fastener through the sticky side of a piece of tape. Tape the fastener to the back of the circle with the Lord.
- 4) Now push the fastener's prongs through the center of the large circle with the faces, so that the Lord's face is in the center of the circle of faces.
- 5) Now push the fastener's prongs through the center of the background paper. You can use a ruler to find the exact center or just estimate.
- 6) Finally, bend the prongs of the fastener down flat on the back of the background paper and tape them down. This will hold the Lord stationary.
- 7) Spin the "faces" wheel!
