For **you**  and for **me**. 























He made **flowers and grass**,

Picture	Description	Picture	Description
Light 	Energetic motion	Moon 	Make a circle to the side of head
Sky 	Looking up	Stars 	Make fingers "twinkle"
Sea 	Wave-like motion	Fish 	Wiggling hand movements
Rain 	Finger rain falling	Birds 	Link thumbs together and flap hands
Land 	Cross and uncross arms	All 	Outward movement indicating many
You 	Hands towards another person	Animals 	Brief animal movements
Me 	Hands towards self	People 	Use of arms indicates two beings
Grass 	Upward hand motion	Finished 	Outward movement indicating "finished"
Fruit 	Hands appear to hold fruit	Gave 	Holding a gift and then giving it forward in a generous gesture
Tree 	Arms make branches	Rest 	Hands crossed, eyes closed
Sun 	Arms form circle above head	Blest 	Arms up like a benediction
