

A FLANNEL BOARD CHRISTMAS SCENE

Here is a Christmas gift for you. The pattern was provided by the ladies of the Washington Society. If you do not have flannel or felt, the figures could be made from colored paper and pasted onto a large piece of paper or cardboard. Extra copies can be made by tracing the figures before you cut them out. This scene would make a lovely Christmas gift for someone in your family. Merry Christmas to you all!

Materials:

- 1 black felt square (12 inches)
- 1 yellow felt square
- 20 inches light blue flannelette (36" wide)
- Some small gold stars
- 18-inch square of heavy cardboard
- 15-inch piece of string or yarn

To Make Your Flannel Board:

1. Along the top, measure 12 inches from each side of the cardboard, and poke 2 holes for the string to hang it with.
2. Thread the string through the holes and knot it together.
3. Measure the blue flannelette to fit over the cardboard, and glue the edges onto the back of the cardboard, making sure that the string is not glued under.,
4. Pin patterns onto felt as indicated.
5. Cut out.
6. Place figures on flannel board as shown below.
7. Dot the sky with gold stars.
8. Hang up your finished scene.
