



Make a Dragon with Wooden Beads

(Revelation 12)

A simple dragon with seven heads can be made using two red pipe cleaners and beads. The dragon could be placed near a picture or representation of the woman clothed with the sun.

Suggested Materials

- 2 red pipe cleaners, cut into three equal pieces
- 7 small clothespins
- 7 red or gold star stickers
- wooden beads (red or painted red)

Procedure

1. Cut one pipe cleaner into three equal sized pieces.
2. Wrap each piece around the top third of the uncut pipe cleaner to create seven heads.
3. Clip one small clothespin to each head.
4. Add a red or gold star sticker to the top of each clothespin to represent the crowns.
5. Have children thread different sized beads (wooden beads could be painted red) onto the longer piece of pipe cleaner.
6. Double the end of the pipe cleaner onto itself to secure the beads.

Other Alternatives for Making the Dragon

- You may want to make the dragon entirely out of pipe cleaners and red cloth. If you have wooden beads, you can string these together (with yarn, string, or even pipe cleaners) to fashion the dragon.
- Another way to make a dragon is to find a gnarled branch in the woods and use clay to make the seven heads.
