

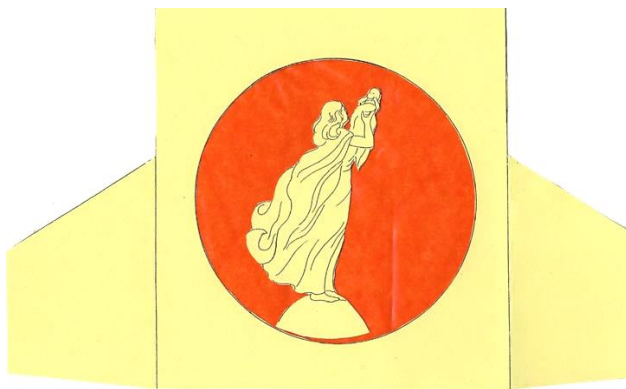
WOMAN CLOTHED WITH THE SUN CANDLE HOLDER

Supplies

Colored tissue paper OR tracing paper and markers, crayons, or colored pencils
Bright-colored construction paper or heavy colored paper
Scissors and glue
Gold metallic pen OR small gold stars

Instructions:

1. Print the candleholder frame onto heavy colored paper or trace onto construction paper. Yellow and Orange are suggested colors. Cut out the frame (including the circle) and fold the frame along the vertical lines so that it can stand up.
2. Print the woman onto heavy paper that is either light yellow or white. If desired, color the woman bright sun colors and the moon silver or gray. Cut the woman out.
3. Use the colored tissue paper or decorate wax paper to make a background for the woman that light can shine through. Cut out a square slightly smaller than the center of the frame. The color can be either an orange for the sun (see example below) or blue for the sky. If it is blue then a smaller sun should be cut out and glued on top (see example at right).



4. Glue the tissue/tracing paper onto the frame. The woman and baby figure should then be glued onto the tissue/tracing paper sun.
5. Add a crown of twelve stars around the woman's head with a gold metallic pen. Small gold stars could be glued to the picture instead of using the gold pen.
6. Place in front of a candle or on a windowsill to see a beautiful silhouette of the woman clothed with the sun!
