Subject: Building the Temple

Age Group: Junior: 9-11

basic supplies:    (MARKERS)  PAPER  PAINT

materials: newspapers, smocks

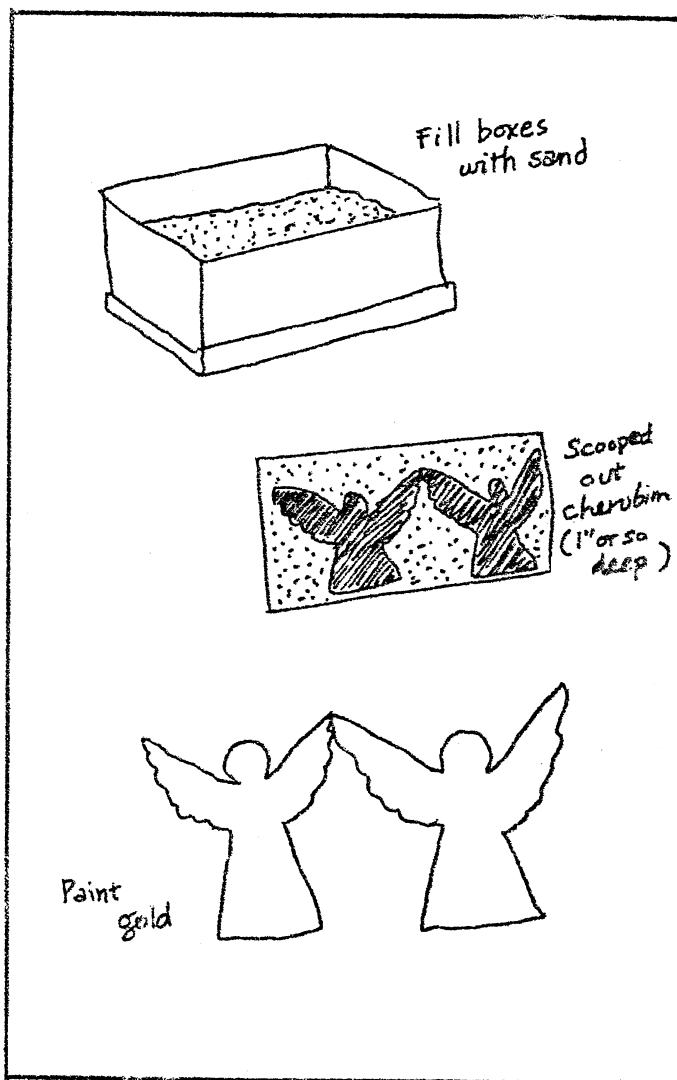
- Sand
- shoe boxes
- Plaster of Paris, water, old spoon, bucket
- gold enamel (spray or brush)
- utensils (popcicle sticks, old spoons...)

teacher preparation:

- practice with plaster to feel comfortable with how much water to add, how long to stir etc.
- Make sample
- Spread newspapers

procedure: • wear smocks

- Fill boxes part way with sand, wet sand
- Using hands and/or utensils, children dig out the shape of the 2 cherubim according to the dimensions given in the chapter (back as tall as it is wide, wings outstretched and touching etc)
- Teacher mixes up plaster with children's help, and pours into each sandcasting
- When hardened, paint gold (read directions on box) after removing from sand



notes: only wet sand enough to form a shape ~ don't soak it
