basic supplies:



materials: smocks, newspaper

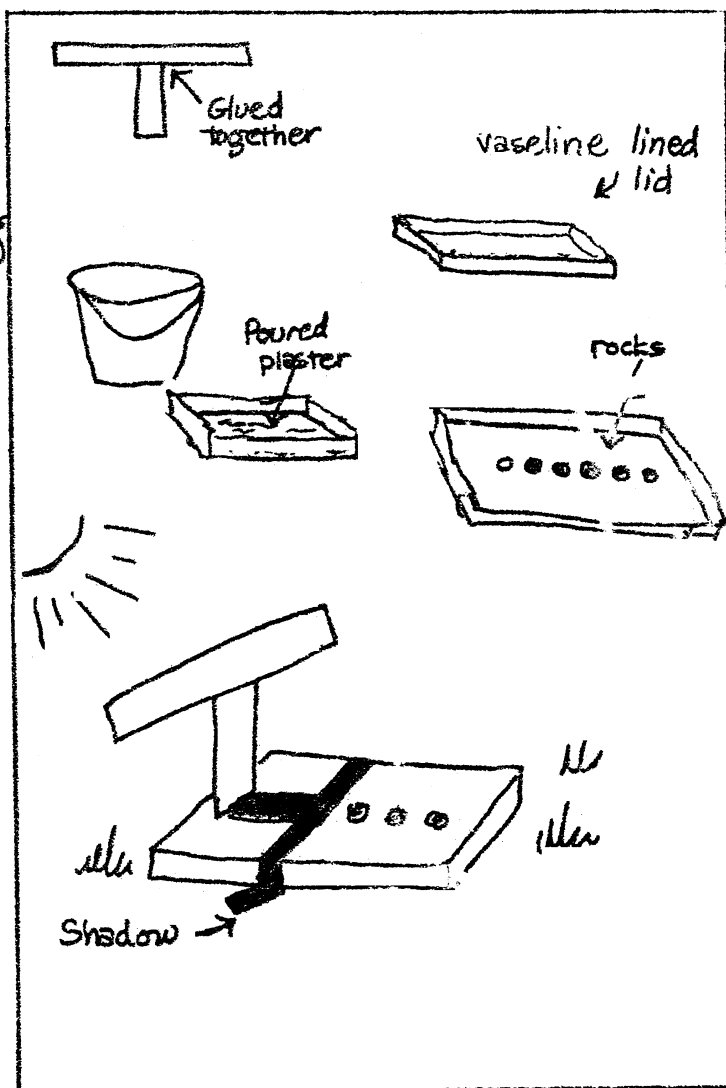
- cardboard lids of shoe boxes
- (lanolin or) vaseline, glue
- plaster of Paris (or patching plaster)
- old bucket or bowl, stick or old spoon
- pretty rocks or marbles or glass chips
- yardsticks, or similar flat wood (lattice!..)

teacher preparation:

- read directions for Plaster
- make sample, and set up outside
- saw yardsticks into pieces, one long (about 7") and one short (about 5") for each child
- glue sticks in a "T" and clamp or weight down until dry
- spread newspapers, or work outside

procedure: read sundial outside

- smear box lid with vaseline (or lanolin)
- mix plaster in bucket with stick or spoon
- pour into lined lids
- put rocks in a row in wet plaster to measure the sun's shadow
- put "T" in wet plaster and prop in place while it dries (using teacher's sundial) go reread sundial outside to see the movement of the shadow since the beginning of class
- either take home in lid or wait until dry to take home



notes: pass out figs to see and eat
• self hardening clay is more expensive, but less messy - you could even just use cardboard for the base
