Basic supplies:



Materials:

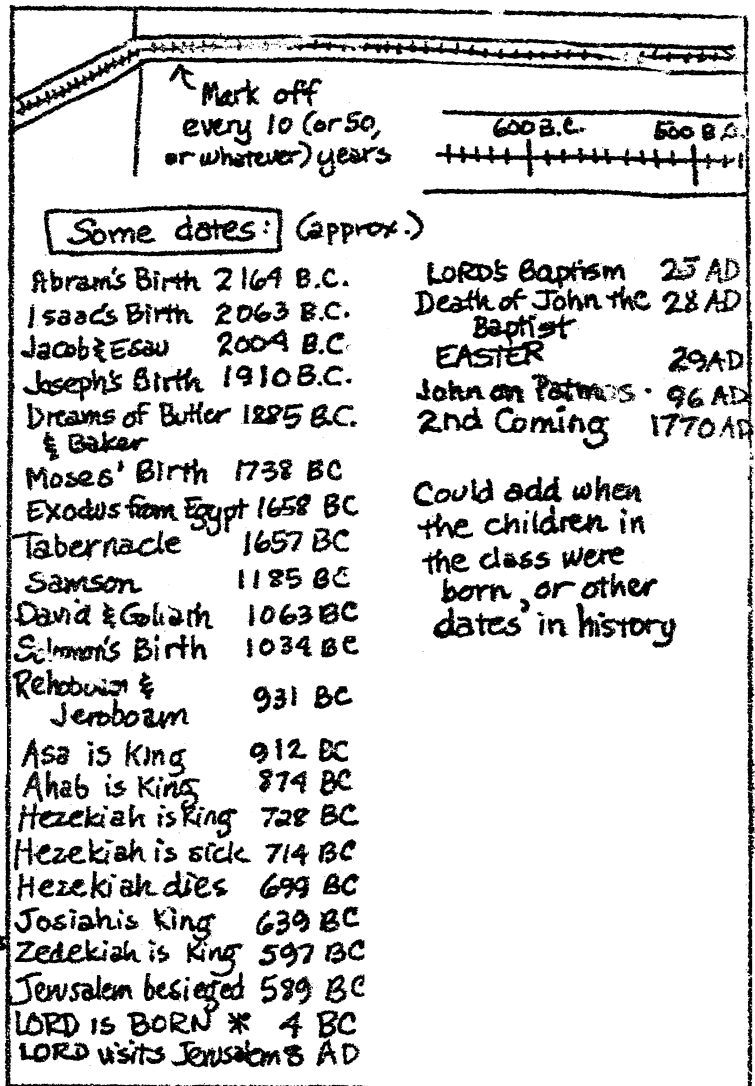
- adding machine paper or other long, thin paper
- markers
- masking tape
- rulers, meter sticks or yardsticks

Teacher preparation:

- give thought to how far you would like the time line to extend ~ the span from Abram to the 2nd Coming is about 4000 years
- write a list of dates and events for children to choose from (ask your minister for reference books ~ Davis Dictionary of the Bible, for example)

Procedure:

- decide on a scale of inches/cm per years (if 1 inch = 10 years, a time line 4000 years will be about 33 feet long ~ about the perimeter of your Sunday School room)
- mark off inches (or cm) all along the paper, writing dates every 100 yrs
- each child chooses events to indicate (and perhaps illustrate very simply) along the time line.
- talk about the 15 years added to Hezekiah's life
- tape the time line to the walls and use as a future reference
