basic supplies:



materials:

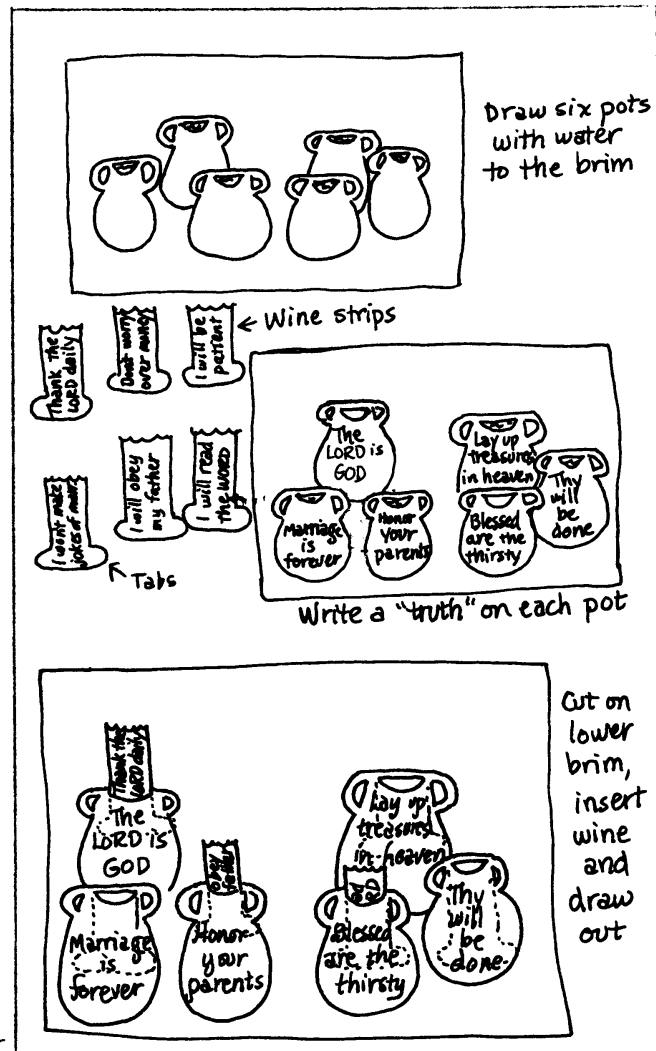
- white paper
- markers
- purple construction paper
- scissors (exacto knives, optional)

teacher preparation:

- make sample

procedure:

- draw six waterpots on white paper with water showing at the brim
- write one true thing you have learned from the WORD on each waterpot (encourage them to come up with their own ideas)
- cut six strips of purple wine as wide as the brims of waterpots (with tabs to keep them from pulling all the way out) and about as long as the pot is tall
- on each of these, write an example of how you could try to live the 6 truths you wrote on the waterpots
- with scissors or exacto knife, cut along the lower brim, and insert wine strip
- draw out the wine, to show how we can use the LORD's truth in our lives
