Basic supplies:



Materials: glue, paper, knife

- square boxes (bottoms of milk or juice cartons)
- colored beads (old necklaces)
- white candles, matches
- green and gold spray paint, newspapers
- little lids, old spoons, odd pieces from old games, small paper cups, small boxes etc.

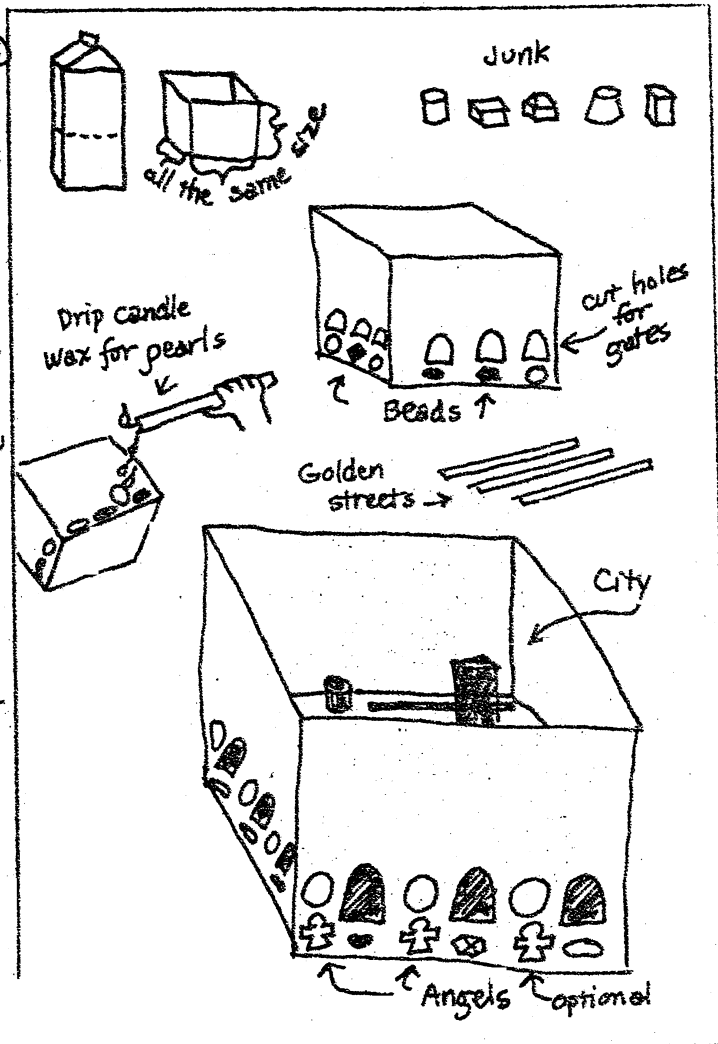
Teacher preparation:

- cut boxes into cubes without lids \*
- spread newspapers in well-ventilated area
- cut paper strips for streets (or you can use the newspaper that catches excess gold spray paint and have children cut streets)

procedure:

- spray boxes green
- spray assorted junk gold (including streets)
- glue beads for foundations, 3 on a side
- drip candle wax for pearls, 3 little puddles on a side
- glue gold "buildings" and streets inside box

\* teacher cuts gates open, either before class or during



Notes: do spray painting first, then lesson while it dries, then finish project

- if desired, you could fold paper strips in 12 folds and cut out angels
- could do as group project
