TEACHER PREPARATION

Read over Matthew 2.

WORSHIP CIRCLE

STORY AND DISCUSSION

Talk about the wise men finding the Baby who was born a King.

Baby Jesus was no longer in the manger, but in a house. The big, bright star had led the wise men to the right house where the little Lord Jesus was. He was a bigger Baby now, for the men had been traveling for many months.

Oh, how happy the wise men were to find the King after their long trip! (Place kneeling wise men on flannel board or hold them up.) They bowed down on their knees before Him, for they knew that this Baby King was God's own Son. (Have children bow down to see what it was like.)

They took their rich gifts from the camels' backs, and opening the beautiful boxes, they gave Him their gold and their sweet-smelling perfume. They thanked God that He had told them about Him. Let us thank God, too, that we know about the Lord Jesus and that we, too, can bring gifts to Him. (Everybody can say what they are thankful for and what they can do for the Lord.)

PROJECT

Ahead of time:

Cut out crown for each child, preferably out of gold cardboard/poster board. It should extend further than the template to fit around the child's head.

Doing the Project:

1. Let them decorate their crowns with colorful stickers, crayons, glitter, jewels, etc.
2. Color a picture of the wise men.
