## **Quotes related to the Lord's Protection**

I will both lie down in peace and sleep; for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety (Psalm 4:8).

Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, just as we hope in You (Psalm 33:22).

The Lord is a shield to all who trust in Him (2 Samuel 22:31).

Let Your loving kindness and Your truth continually preserve me (Psalm 40:11).

Hear my prayer, O Lord, and let my cry come to You (Psalm 102:1).

You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You (Isaiah 26:3).

"Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid" (John 14:27).

"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28).

Nothing at all could harm people whom the Lord is protecting, not even if the whole of hell were surrounding them, both from without and from within (*Arcana Coelestia* 968).

When the Lord is with someone He leads him and makes provision so that all that happens, whether sad or joyful, may bring him what is good (see *Arcana Coelestia* 6303).

The Lord leads a person as if by the hand, permitting and withholding as far as a person is willing to follow in freedom (see *Apocalypse Explained* 1174:2).

Peace holds within itself trust in the Lord, the trust that He governs all things and provides all things, and that He leads toward an end that is good (*Arcana Coelestia* 8455:1).
