

basic supplies: & GUE OF (MARKERS)











materials: paint


- rostmest boxes
- · hole punchers
- · shiny paper (gold, silver, rca.)
- · egg cartons (optional)
- ·knife

teacher preparation:

- ·begin punching little holes from the shiny paper (use compartments of egg corton to separate colors).
- · paint oatmeal boxes to cover labels or give colored paper over it

## procedure:

- · cut a crown from the oatmeal box
- · purch lots of shiny dots (punch several at once)
  · glue dots to crown like a mosaic
- ·encourage children to cover surface of crown (no overlapping, though)



notes: discuss who we want to be our king · glue should go on crowns, not dots -twelzers
