Bringing Fruit to the Lord—A Thanksgiving Procession

This project shows families bringing an offering of fruit to the front of the church in Bryn Athyn, Pennsylvania USA. This church is a cathedral with stone walls and beautiful stained glass windows. The families walking up to the minister who is standing before the chancel with its lighted candles and open Word.

To make this project, color the picture with colored pencils, crayons, or fine tip markers. Then position the pages and tape them together.

Here are some coloring suggestions:

- 1. Color the stained glass windows in pale shades of red, blue, lavender, green and gold as if the light were shining through them.
- 2. Color the candlesticks gold and the altar light brown. There is a red cover on the Word. The candles are white with orange or yellow flames.
- 3. The minister's robe is white with a blue stole around his neck and a gold belt.
- 4. The children and parents are wearing their best clothes in all your favorite colors. Their hair might be black, brown, yellow or red.
- 5. The stone archways and the pillars between them are various shades of light gray or tan.
