DRAMATIZING ANGELIC QUALITIES

- Divide a larger group into small groups of two or three people.
- Each small group draws a card with an angelic quality or characteristic and the group acts it out.
- Everyone else tries to guess which angelic quality is being displayed.

Variation: Older children and teens could dramatize an opposite of an angelic quality and have the others guess what the matching angelic quality would be. We can learn a great deal about what is good by seeing its opposite.

Note: With young children (generally those nine years old and younger), it is better to dramatize only the angelic qualities and perhaps talk about (but not have children act out) the opposites.
