Drawing Project: Felt Tip Pen Painting

Level: All

Time: 15-30 minutes

Materials Needed

paper (not too absorbent) colored markers (felt tip pens) paint brush (medium to small) water



Steps

- 1. Draw a picture using markers.
- 2. A small child can go over the picture with a wet paintbrush any which way. Colors will run.
- 3. Older children will want to control the running of the colors by painting from the outside of figure toward the inside. They will also want to rinse out the brush between "painting" different colored figures.

Application Ideas

Any story can be illustrated. Perhaps this method would be most appropriate for stories with water in them, such as:

John Baptizing Jesus Jonah and the Whale Moses in the Bulrushes The Great Flood The River of Life

The correspondence or meaning of water being truth can be brought out when using water to help make the water in the story look more like water. But it would be good to look up the meaning of the water in each story since the water of the Great Flood would actually stand for falsity.
