Drawing Project: Wax Resist

Level: All (though older children may find this too simple)

Time: 15-30 minutes

Materials Needed

crayon, chalk, or colored pencil light-colored paper water colors large paint brush

Preparation

Prepare water color paint and water in several containers for a large class.

Steps

- 1. Draw picture with crayon, chalk, or colored pencil. Make sure all figures are filled in well with color.
- 2. Paint all over the picture with water color paints.
- 3. The crayon, chalk, or colored pencil will resist the water in the paint and show through. The parts of the picture that are not colored will be painted.

Application Ideas

Stories that could be illustrated with an underwater picture (such as the miraculous catch of fishes) or stories that take place at night.
