Game Directions

Object of the Game:

Be the first player to reach the Promised Land (the Land of Canaan).

Set-Up:


- * Needed: Game markers and one die.
- * Place the cards in one pile with the question side facing up. Arrange them so that they are in order, with number one at the top.

How to Play:

- 1. All players place their game markers at **START** on the game board.
- 2. Players take turns picking up the top card and trying to **answer the question**. Then the card is returned to the bottom of the pile, face up.
 - * If the answer is **CORRECT**, the player may roll the die and move his/her game marker forward (toward the Land of Canaan). It is now the next player's turn.
 - * If the answer is **INCORRECT**, the player may not move and it is the next player's turn.

Once all the cards have been gone through, go through them again. You may remember more of the answers each time you play.
