This project has a special door that opens to reveal the picture of the Lord.

Materials: 2 pieces of paper (construction paper would be ideal) scissors crayons, colored pencils, or markers


Procedure:

- 1. Make a picture of the Lord (or cut out the colored picture supplied on the next page).
- 2. Draw a door in the middle of one piece of paper. Cut along three sides of the door so that it can fold open and shut.



- 3. Lay the page with the door on top of the other piece of paper. Position the picture of the Lord between the 2 pages so that it shows when you open the door. Glue or tape the picture of the Lord in place.
- 4. Write above or below the door:

The "King of Glory" OR "The King of glory shall come in" (Psalm 24:8).
