

Make a Collage of Seeds from the Lord

The Lord created plants in a way that provides seeds that can produce new plants. Take a nature walk to find seeds for trees, flowers, vegetables, and fruits. Make a collage with some of the seeds the Lord gives us.

Procedure:

- 1. Collect seeds from nature or provide other seeds. (If you are unable to find as many seeds as you would like, try supplementing with seeds found in produce from the market.)
- 2. It is preferable to use dried seeds.

Note: Young children will find it easiest to manipulate larger seeds such as:

pumpkin or other squash seeds sunflower seeds pinto beans

- 3. Give each child a small piece of cardboard (or card stock).
- 4. Encourage children to think about whether they want to make a picture or abstract design with the seeds or just place them in any way that appeals to them.
- 5. Apply white glue (such as Elmer's) where you want to put seeds. Then set seeds on the glue.
- 6. If you want to use small seeds (like birdseed), try spreading glue on the cardboard and then sprinkling the seeds on top.

Optional: Draw one or more of the fruits that come from the seeds you glue on the cardboard.
