Materials: for making a timbrel or tamborine to celebrate the Lord's help, you'll need for each child: -one aluminum pie plate -about 8 metal bolts or washers

or buttons

- colorful yarn; maybe streamers teacher preparation:

-cut yarn into 4 lengths per child, each length = 6"long

-make piles of bolts, etc. on the table, so children can choose their favorites

## procedure:

- -punch 4 holes in the sides of the aluminum pans, with pencil or scissors.
- Thread 2 bolts, etc.) onto each yarn piece.
- Tie each yarn piece onto pie pan at each hole
- Maybe you could tape a few long streamers to it for decoration.
