## **MAZE OR LABYRINTH?**

People who attribute everything to their prudence are like those who wander in dark forests and do not know the way out; and if they find it they attribute their success either to their own prudence or to fortune (Arcana Coelestia 6485).

Are you someone who thinks everything happens because you are smart enough to control it? If so, you are like someone wandering in a maze.

## Make a maze:

- Make it complicated.
- The overall picture could look like a forest, with the maze wandering in and out through the trees.
- Make lots of blind ends.
- Give it to a friend or a family member to try.

The infinite ways the Lord leads us "appear like a labyrinth even before the angels of the third heaven" (Apocalypse Explained 1153:7).

Are you someone who knows that the Lord is always leading all of us? He is always leading us toward heaven. If you can believe that, you are someone in a labyrinth. A labyrinth is a long and convoluted path, but it has only one way to go and that is the right one. It is different from a maze in that you can't get lost. All you have to do is follow.

## Draw a labyrinth:

- You can make it really complicated, but it will have one twisting path.
- It could also look like it is going through a forest, but the person following it knows he WILL come out.
