Family Lesson – The Twelve Apostles (Mark 3) Level 2 – Following the Lord

Following the Lord Mobile

The Lord called the twelve disciples to follow Him in the world. We can all be the Lord's disciples too. You can make a mobile to show that you, your family, and friends can all be His disciples.

Materials needed

scissors
string or yarn
2 sticks or wooden dowels
4 paper rectangles (print attached page or make your own)
wax crayons, colored markers, or colored pencils
optional: clear (transparent) tape



Directions

1. Hold the 2 sticks to make a cross and tied them together in the middle with string or year. Leave extra string to hang the mobile from this intersection.

Now you are ready to make the pictures for you mobile!

- 2. Print the page with four rectangles (see attached) or divide a piece of paper into 4 equal sections.
- 3. Draw a picture in each section to show you, your family, and some of your friends.
- 4. Cut out each section along the lines. Write the name of each person on the back of your picture. Then write "Disciple of the Lord" under each name. (You may need help with this.)

Now you are ready to assemble the mobile.

- 5. Make holes in the top of the pictures about ½" from the edge. (You may want to put some clear tape across the hole to keep it from tearing.)
- 6. Tie one end of a piece of string or yarn through the hole. Tie the other end to the crossed mobile sticks Repeat until all 4 pictures are hung on the sticks to create a mobile.

(Note: The pictures will spin if they are hung at different levels.)
