# Sun, Moon and Stars Streamer

The Lord gives us warmth and light by means of the sun, moon and stars. Create a streamer showing the sun, moon and stars. When the projects are finished, stand up and hold streamers high. Follow the leader and have a parade! See the sun, moon and stars trail across the "sky" behind each child.

- 1. Set up the supplies so that each child has what he or she needs within easy reach. Each child needs a sun, moon and 3 stars, ribbon or yarn, glue and glitter.
- 2. Cut out the sun, moon and stars. *Note*: cutting approximate shapes is fine.
- 3. Spread glue on one side of the sun. Sprinkle with gold glitter.
- 4. Spread glue on one side of the moon. Sprinkle with silver glitter.
- 5. Spread glue on one side of each star. Sprinkle with your choice of gold or silver glitter (since they are distant suns).
- 6. Lay the sun, moon and stars over the ribbon or yarn attached to the pencil, spacing them evenly. Tape the back side of each piece to the yarn or string.
- 7. Stand in line. Holding on to the pencil, raise hands to the sky. Walk in a line and have a parade—around the room, through the hallway, or even outside!



#### **Materials for Each Child**

Sun, Moon and Stars p. 2 printed on yellow paper, scissors, glue, gold and silver glitter, piece of yarn or ribbon approx. 36" (90cm) long, new unsharpened pencil, tape

### Prepare in Advance

Tape or tie the yarn or ribbon to the pencils. For younger children, cut out the sun, moon and stars.

## **Easy Glitter Cleanup**

Sprinkle glitter over a baking tray to catch spills. Tip the glitter into a corner of the tray and pour back into the container when done.
