## Fishermen

This project illustrates how men fished in the time of Jesus.

## Suggested Supplies:

1 9"x12" blue or another color of construction paper (to mount the picture on)

1 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ "x11" printed page of the Lord with fishermen

fish (print full page and give half to each student)

tulle fabric

crayons, glue, scissors, staples

## Project instructions:

- 1. Using crayons, color the outline drawing of Jesus with the fishermen. Glue this picture onto the blue construction paper to give it more stability and to form a frame around your project.
- 2. Using crayons, color the fish and cut them out.
- 3. Fold the piece of tulle fabric in half lengthwise with the opening at the top forming a little pocket. Using staples, attach the ends of the tulle netting to the page, along the side of the boat near the net in the picture.
- 4. You can now retell the story of Jesus calling the fishermen to be His first disciples. Put the fish into the net to demonstrate how men fished in those times.
