DISCUSSION

(from General Church Religion Lessons for Preschool)

The Lord is our Heavenly Father!

- 1. He loves you very much, just like your Daddy does.
 - a. He cares for you always and keeps you from harm.
 - b. He makes things grow for food, clothes, homes, books, toys.
 - c. He made the world.
 - d. He made your Daddy and Mommy.
 - e. He made You!
- 2. You love the Lord very much
 - a. You want to obey Him to make Him happy.
 - b. You can feel sage and warm and happy <u>all the time</u> when you think about the Lord, because He is <u>always</u> with you.

It makes the Lord happy when you talk to Him!

- 1. How? Just look at His picture, or close your eyes and think about Him so you van see Him inside your head, and talk.
 - a. Tell Him:
 - what makes you happy
 - what makes you sad
 - what you need His help with
 - what you are sorry for doing
 - what you are thankful for
- 2. Let us each tell the Lord something now.
