

The Lord Riding on a White Horse Stained Glass Window

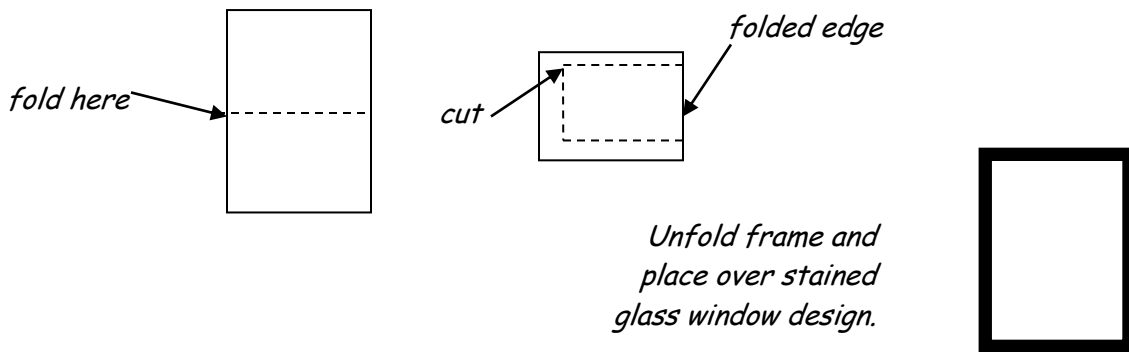
(Revelation 19)

Suggested Materials

window design printed on white paper or translucent paper (such as tracing paper)
colored markers, colored pencils, or wax crayons
optional: salad oil and brush or paper towel
optional: black construction paper for making a frame

Procedure

1. Use colored markers, pencils, oil pastels, or wax crayons to color the design.
2. Remember that the horse is white and the Lord's robe is described as "dipped in blood."
3. If you are using regular white paper, you may want to brush it (the colored side) lightly with salad oil after coloring. This will make it somewhat translucent so that it looks like a stained glass window.
4. Optional Frame: To make a black frame for the window
 - a. fold the black construction paper in half
 - b. use a ruler and pencil to make a line about 1 inch from all edges except the fold
 - c. cut along the lines so that you have cut a large rectangle out of the full page
 - d. unfold the paper, center the design within the frame, and then tape into place



5. Display in a sunny window so that the light can shine through the beautiful picture.
