basic supplies:











materials: blue & white string, large needless

·white or tan leather or fabric (≈ 30"×10")
· red leather or fabric (≈ 30"×10")

white wool or fabric (1-30"x20",1-30"x24")

striped fabric ~ white, blue, purple, red (or es close to that as you can fink) (2-38" × 20"; 2-10" × 10"; 1-5" × 20"); gold spray paint teacher preparation: card band

cut out a stencil for the cherubin to spray design on striped fabric

· mark 50 dots along one edge on each of the woul & 1st 2 striped curtains (the 30" or 28" side)

procedure:


· with blue string (or heavy thread) and heldle, make loops to sew the 2 striped curtains together

· have another child working on the white wool curtains, using white string to loop them together

· have other children spray paint cheribin on the striped 10" × 10" veils, as well as the striped curtains

· then loop one of the 10" × 10" veils to the middle loops of the otriped curtains such that it will hang down to divide the Holy of Holies from the Holy Place

attatch the 2nd 10" x 10" veil to the 5 poles made the week tefore, with finishing nails



NOTES: Explain that the real curtains were fastened with 50 copper or gold hooks on the loops, and the inner 2 were strips sewn together.

This is meant to take 2 weeks, and be coordinated with the other ofe groups
