A Valentine for Dad or Grandpa

1. Color the quiver on the next page. (You may want to mount the whole page onto stiff paper or cardboard.

2. Carefully cut along the white dotted lines at the top of the quiver.

3. Now cut out one heart shape for each child in the family, tracing more hearts as necessary.


4. Have each child draw a picture of him or herself on a heart. An alternative is to cut their faces out of photographs and mount them on the heart shapes.


5. Make "arrows" out of the hearts by mounting each one onto the end of a craft stick, or a pipecleaner, or even a twig from the garden.

6. Stick all the "arrows" through the slit in the top of the quiver so that they stick up out of it.

7. Tape or glue the other ends of "arrows" to the back of the project.

8. Now children can write their names and messages for Dad on the front of the page around the sides of the quiver.
