## **Helping Others Helps God Discussion Questions**

- 1. Describe a time when you did a small act of kindness for someone else.
  - a. How did it make you feel?
  - b. How do you think it made them feel?
  - c. Did it seem like love multiplied?
- 2. Describe a time when you felt full of energy.
  - a. Where does energy come from?
- 3. Describe a time when you felt really happy.
  - a. Why do think that was?
  - b. What did it have to do with feeling loved, or feeling loving or useful?
- 4. Describe a time when you felt like you had no energy.
  - a. Why do you think that was?
- 5. What relationship might there be between feeling unhappy and feeling unloved, or *not* feeling loving or useful?
- 6. What makes the Lord feel "hungry"?
- 7. How does the Lord feel when people are loving to each other?
