White Horse Stained Glass Window Puzzle - Revelation 19:11-16

This puzzle would make a lovely decoration when completed. It has 100 pieces and so is relatively complicated and time consuming to assemble. You might want to do it as a group or family project over two sessions. You will need a piece of posterboard or a large piece of cardboard for backing and tape. The finished puzzle will be about 19" wide and 17½" high.

- 1. Print out the 10 pages of this project and cut out the pieces on the following 9 pages (there are 100 of them).
- 3. Using the picture below as a guide, begin to lay out the edge pieces along the perimeter of your backing. Black lines should overlap. Put a roll of tape on the back of each piece to hold it in place, but so it can still be moved if necessary.
- 4. Continue placing pieces working from the edges into the center. Don't worry if things don't fit exactly.
- 5. When the puzzle is complete, you may want to add extra pieces of tapes to hold down some edges.
- 6. Trim the backing board as necessary and display your stained glass window!

This picture is a design for a stained glass lamp that hangs in the office of the President of the Academy of the New Church and is copyrighted to that organization. In the real window, the colored pieces are glass and the black lines are called leading which holds the glass together. To learn more about how stained glass is made, you might want to get *The Angel of the Lord* which is about some of the windows in the Bryn Athyn Cathedral and includes "The Story of Stained Glass."
