- Write a poem or prayer to the Lord using a few of the terms that particularly struck you.
- Pick one or two of the words that you are not familiar with and look them up in a dictionary. Think about the nuances or subtle differences in meaning between different words.
- In a group, choose some of the words to write on cards that are then put into a bowl. Have each person pick out one card and say what that word or phrase means to them in their relationship with the Lord.
- Choose a few of these terms to look up in the Heavenly Doctrine using Potts' Concordance, Newsearch, or <a href="www.heavenlydoctrines.org">www.heavenlydoctrines.org</a>. Does what is said there further illuminate the ideas of praising and worshipping the Lord?
